Due to restructuring within the Georgia Department of Corrections additional administrative space was needed at their Diagnostic Site in Jackson. TSW's Architecture Studio was selected to provide full design and construction phase services for the 11,000 square foot facility including site selection, cost analysis, and sustainability modeling and consulting.

Georgia Peach sustainability goals evidence themselves in many innovative and beautiful ways: through rapidly renewable and locally-sourced pine timber framing, deep overhangs that protect facades from glaring sun and rain, bioswale garden designs within the parking lot, sun tunnels which pipe daylight deep into interior spaces, motion sensing switching, and high efficiency HVAC systems. This building earned a prestigious two Peaches.

With careful planning, choosing readily available materials and smart detailing the building was completed on-time and under a tight budget.
