

# LAKE ARROWHEAD

Waleska, Georgia



Part of our planning role at Lake Arrowhead was the theming of new amenity facilities for this 8,000-acre second home and resort community in northern Cherokee County, Georgia. To underscore the property's spectacular mountain and lake setting, TSW developed an architectural language inspired by American mountain lodge and resort design. These building styles were heavily influenced by the turn-of-the-century Arts and Crafts movement which was characterized by rugged heavy timber framing, open rafter-tail roof eaves, and massive stonework elements.

TSW also provided landscape architectural services for the primary entry and common areas.
