

STONE HARBOR CLUBHOUSE

Cape May Courthouse, New Jersey



Located in a 360 acre golf community on rolling coastal terrain, Stone Harbor's design is inspired by traditional Pennsylvania and Mid-Atlantic rural architecture. Regional exterior materials include white clapboard siding, Pennsylvania quarried stone, native red brick and granite pavers.

The floor plan accommodates both formal dining and grill rooms from a single centralized kitchen. Both dining areas open onto a 1,500 sq. ft. fabric covered stone terrace, which overlooks the eighteenth green. Men's and women's locker facilities are on the lower level, which daylights to the clubhouse event terrace. Stone Harbor was named "Best Private Clubhouse in America" by Golf Inc. Magazine in 1994.
