

TWELVE STONES CROSSING

Nashville, Tennessee



Twelve Stones serves as both a daily-fee golf clubhouse and a neighborhood restaurant to the rapidly growing communities of north Nashville. Located on a rural estate with a 100 year old log farmhouse, the 7,000 sq. ft. clubhouse uses the original rooms of this home as intimate dining spaces, then adds new construction for the proshop, kitchen and golfer's grill porch. Adjoining the dining porch is a large event patio overlooking the golf course.

Much care was given to create a true Tennessee farmhouse feel, while simultaneously providing the golf operation a distinctive, signature look. The large stone chimneys recall older clubhouses, and denote where new construction is merging with the original farmhouse.
