McDONOUGH – Following a successful series of community charrettes, the draft recommendations for Henry County’s Hudson Bridge-Jonesboro Roads Connector Activity Center Livable Centers Initiative (LCI) Study are ready to be unveiled. The plan incorporate public comments and includes recommendations for the character of future development, transportation improvements, new open space, and more.

At the upcoming Draft Plan Presentation, members of the public will have the chance to hear about the draft recommendations first hand, and view a series of colorful concept plans showing the potential future character of key areas. Plan consultants will explain recommended concepts in detail, and discuss tools for making them a reality. Following a formal presentation, opportunities will be provided for the public to provide public comment. Based on these comments, the consultant team will develop a final vision and plan for presentation at a subsequent public meeting.

The presentation will be held in the Community Room of the Henry County Administration Building at 140 Henry Parkway in McDonough, GA on **Tuesday, February 16, 2010**, starting at **6:30 p.m.**

The LCI study presents an opportunity for “Smart Growth” options within the study area. Its success is critical to future quality of life for Henry County citizens.
